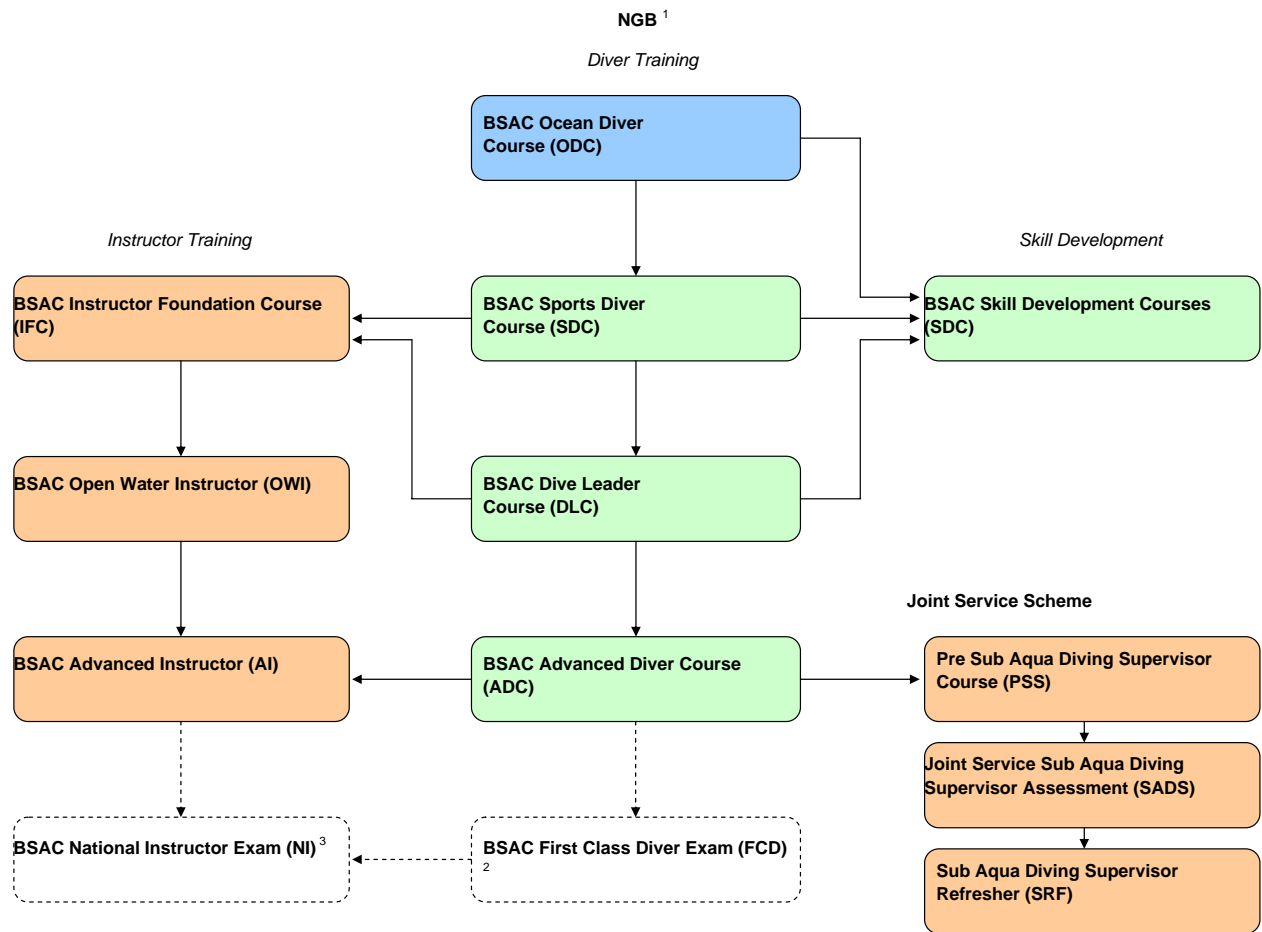


JSAT SUB AQUA DIVING SCHEME



NOTES

1. All courses within the sub aqua scheme are civilian (NGB) with the exception of the SADS Scheme. Only experienced BSAC Advanced Divers and above qualify to attend.
2. First Class Diver is the governing body's highest diving qualification and is assessed centrally through BSAC HQ.
3. National Instructor is the governing body's highest diving instructor qualification and is assessed centrally through BSAC HQ.
